6 7 8 9	MEMBERS PRESENT: Chairman Lemois, Commissioners Koutsogiane, Matta, Parent, Ouellette, Champagne and Scullin. Deputy Chief Anderson, Finance Director Diane Karolyshyn and Tax Collector Fountain.

11 12 13	CONSENT AGENDA:
14 15 16 17	The Chairman explained the four sets of minutes can be approved as a group or individually. Commissioner Champane moved to approve the minutes from May 19, 24, 26 and June 8, seconded by Commissioenr Ouellette.
18 19 20 21 22	Mr. Koutsogiane stated that the minutes do not reflect accuratly what is said or done during the minutes. He feels he has been quoted incorrectly on a number of occations. He also feels some of the important points he has tried to bring to the borad's attentiono are not stated, that they are inaccurate, they have been modified.
23 24 25	Mr. Koutsogiane stated he was going to voice his objection to each one of these minutes as not accurate for those reasons.
26 27 28 29	The Chairman stated to Mr. Koutsogiane that there is a policy at the committee level allowing changes to the minutes. Reviewing that the changes just need to be presented and they would be put in the minutes.
30 31 32 33	Mr. Koutsogiane stated that he has done that before and the changes were not entered. The Chairman asked for the specific times that has happened. Mr. Koutsogiane said he didn't have them with him. The Chairman asked if he would like to have that issue on the next meeting's agenda and he agreed.
34 35 36 37	Commissioner Champange state that it seems that every month Mr. Koutsogiane has an issue with the minutes. He continued to remind us that the Solicitor has stated that minutes are no more than a record of events of the meetings, not nescessary a verbatum record of a member's dialog.
38 39 40 41 42 43	Commissioner Champange continued and suggested that it is time we need to investigate the hiring of a court stenogrpher. This would be to stop the issue that Mr. Koutsogiane and others have the minutes. He also noted that there would be a cost, from what he has heard it is about \$300 per meeting. But to stop the back and forth and finally put it to rest, once the court stenogrpher takes the minutes it's going to be a little hard to say "my comments are included."

Mr. Koutsogiane suggested that the Clerk go to the video and ensure that his important comments are in the minutes.

The Chairman pointed out to Mr. Koutsogiane, that what you just stated is what the stenogrpher would eleminate. Because only you really know which commments you make are important. He continued to point out that the Clerk enters, by what ever standard, what she feels should go into the minutes.

He again pointed out that we have a policy allowing for changes to be made to the minutes prior to acceptance.

Commissioner Ouellette suggest to Mr. Koutsogiane that he can take the written minutes and listen to the video and use the time stamp on the video. This would be a sure way to be truly accurate and this should addres he concerns. She asked him if that would make sense.

Mr. Koutsogiane said he apprecited her commments and that is exactly what he has done in the past. He stated that even after presenting those changes they still don't appear in the minutes. Ms. Ouellette continued to ask if Mr. Koutsogiane could make notes and pass them out to the committee for accurate reviewing. He again stated he appreciated that comment and he feels the job could be done better the first time around. Rather than doing all that additional work; which he will do as he stated.

Mr. Champange added that it comes down to either we want transcripts of the meeting or do we want minutes. If we want transcripts we hire the court stenogrpher and pay the price and it should make Mr. Koutsogiane very happy.

The Chairman pointed out that the mintues for May 24th where done by the clerk and are about five or six pages. He expressed his appreciation and acknowledgment of the work she is doing.

Commissioner Ouellette pointed out that from the CFD web site all the meeting videos are easily accessed so all that is needed is cross referencing.

Mr. Koutsogiane pointed out that June 8th meeting is not there. The Chairman pointed out that the video equipment was not available and that the mintues met the requirments of the Open Meeting Act.





