3 **Tax Assessment Levy**
4 **Fiscal Year 2016-2017**

5
6 RESOLUTION: That the Cumberland Fire District shall collect a tax levy.

7
8 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CFD COMMITTEE AS FOLLOWS:**

9
10 **SECTION 1: The Cumberland Fire Committee hereby orders the assessment and collection of a**
11 **a tax on the ratable real estate and tangible personal property in a sum not less than**
12 **\$6,835,553 or more than \$7,235,554.**

13
14 **SECTION 2: Said tax is for ordinary expenses, charges for the payment of interest and other**
15 **indebtedness, in whole or in part, of the town and for other purposes authorized by law.**

16
17 **SECTION 3: ~~The tax assessor shall assess and apportion said tax on the inhabitants and~~**
18 **~~ratable property of the town as of the 31st day of December, 2015, at twelve o'clock~~**
19 **~~midnight, according to law, and shall on completion of said assessment date, date, certify,~~**
20 **~~and sign the same and deliver to and deposit to and deposit the same in the office of the~~**
21 **~~clerk on or before the May 1, 2016.~~ The Cumberland Finance Director shall proceed and**
22 **collect said tax from persons and estates liable therefor unless by law otherwise provided.**

23
24 **~~SECTION 4: The clerk, on receipt of said assessment, shall forthwith make a copy of the same~~**
25 **~~and deliver it to the Cumberland Finance Director, who shall proceed and collect said tax~~**
26 **~~from persons and estates liable therefore, unless by law otherwise provided.~~**

27
28 **SECTION 5: Said tax shall be due and payable on the 15th of July, 2016.**

29
30 **If the first installment or any succeeding installment of taxes is not paid by the last date of**
31 **the respective unpaid balance period or periods as they occur, then the whole tax or**
32 **remaining unpaid balance of the taxes, as the case may be, shall immediately become due**
33 **and payable and carry until collected a penalty at the rate of twelve (12%) per annum.**

34
35 **However, said tangible personal property and real estate taxes may be paid in quarterly**
36 **Installments, as follows:**

- 37
38 **1. The first installment of twenty-five percent (25%) on or before the 15th day of July,**
39 **2016.**
40 **2. The second installment of twenty-five percent (25%) on or before the 15th day of**
41 **October 2016.**

- 42 **3. The third installment of twenty-five percent (25%) on or before the 15th day of**
43 **January, 2017.**
44 **4. The fourth and final twenty-five percent (25%) on or before the 15th day of April,**
45 **2017.**

46
47 **Each installment of taxes, if paid within five (5) business days of each installment due date will be**
48 **free from any charge of interest.**

49
50 **SECTION 6: All tangible personal property and real estate bills totaling one hundred dollars or less**
51 **for the year, will be due in full on or before the 15th day of July, 2016.**

52
53 **SECTION 7: Any of said taxes not paid on or before July 20, 2016 shall be collected**
54 **by levy upon sale of the real estate upon which it is assessed or by other due process of law.**



56 **SECTION 8: There shall be a minimum bill calculated of twenty-five dollars (\$25.00).**

58 **SECTION 9: This levy shall take effect upon its passage and all resolution or portions thereof**
59 **which are inconsistent herewith are hereby appealed.**

62 **NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CUMBERLAND FIRE DISTRICT AS FOLLOWS:**

64 **The Cumberland Fire District collect as required the needed tax levy.**
