Chief's Report for June 2021

Board of Commissioners Cumberland Fire District June 22, 2021

Commissioners,

The Cumberland Fire District responded to 264 calls for service in the month of May. You may find additional information in the supplied report.

Ongoing training items consisted of Mental Health First Aid and Emergency Medical Technician Recertification. The Cumberland Water Rescue and Recovery Team in partnership with the Friends of the Blackstone trained at the Pratt Dam. The firefighters trained with technical rescue evolutions. This training was performed nearly a year after our last successful rescue of a person trapped in the Pratt Dam tubes.

The Fire Inspector has been aggressively bringing apartment buildings to compliance. The Inspector Lavallee is also handling all complaints and safety concerns for the department. I have no doubt the citizens are safer due to the hardworking individuals in fire prevention. I would like to add Administrative Assistant Keri Smith has been coordinating the efforts for inspections, follow-ups, and plan review.

Injured on duty reports remain the same. One firefighter with occupational cancer and one firefighter being seen for a knee injury. We do have Firefighter on Probation Walmsley graduating from the Municipal Academy on Friday. He will need to complete four weeks of in house training then will be assigned as a floater to reduce overtime costs.

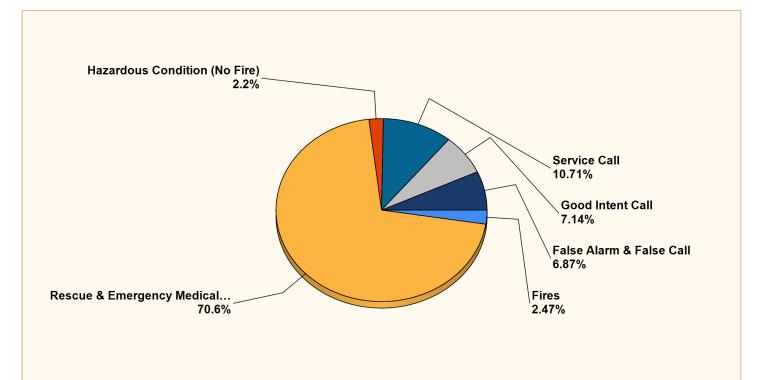
