The Cumberland Fire Committee hereby orders the assessment and 9 collection of a tax on the ratable real estate and tangible personal property in a 10 sum not less than \$ 8,508,803.00 nor more than \$ 8,682,452.00. 11 12 Section 2. Said tax is for ordinary expenses, charges for payment of interest and 13 other indebtedness, in whole or in part, of the fire district and for other purposes 14 authorized by law. 15 16 Section 3. The Cumberland Fire District Tax Collector shall proceed and collect 17 said tax from persons and estates libel therefore unless by law otherwise 18 provided. 19 20 Section 4.
