RESOLUTION: To authorize Fire Chief Nicholas Anderson to enter into a purchase and sale agreement for a used fire apparatus from Greenwood Emergency Vehicles.

WHEREAS: The Cumberland Fire District is need of upgrading its fleet of trucks. This purchase would replace Engine 2, a 1992 E-One, that was damaged by an accident on March 16, 2021.

WHEREAS: The Cumberland Fire District received an insurance settlement from VFIS for the cost of repairing the accident damage to Engine 2 in the amount of \$40,231.84.

WHEREAS: Chief Nicholas Anderson became aware of a 2002 E-One replacement engine. The vehicle was refurbished in 2014 with new frame rails, paint, and LED warning lights.

WHEREAS: It is fiscally prudent to purchase the 2002 E-One for \$30,000 rather than repair the current 1992 Engine 2 at a cost of \$40,231.84.

WHEREAS: Chief Nicholas Anderson brought the vehicle to Ralco Equipment Company Inc. Their review of the vehicle disclosed a few minor light repairs. They also recommended acquiring this vehicle as a replacement.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CUMBERLAND FIRE DISTRICT AS FOLLOWS:

RESOLVED: Chief Nicholas Anderson is authorized to enter into a purchase and sale agreement with Greenwood Emergency Vehicles for a 2002 E-One Engine at a cost of \$30,000.
